The enclosed documents are important, so please review and complete them carefully. The above referenced **permit will expire on December 31, 2015**. Action is required on your part to ensure a smooth renewal process.

In accordance with DEQ's procedural and enforcement rules for issuance of permits [Oregon Administrative Rules, Divisions 12 and 45], you must complete and submit the enclosed permit renewal application at least 180 days before your current permit is scheduled to expire. Meeting this submittal date will automatically extend and keep your current permit in effect until a new permit is issued.

The application package should be mailed to: Department of Environmental Quality, Attn: Permit Coordinator, 700 NE Multnomah Street, Suite 600, Portland, OR 97232. The renewal fee, filing fee and annual compliance fee for all permits have been combined into a single fee that is now billed annually. Therefore, no fees are required with your renewal. However, if modification of effluent limits is being requested by this application, a permit modification fee will be assessed.

If you no longer conduct activities requiring this permit, please notify DEQ in writing so that your permit may be terminated.

Failure to submit a permit renewal application at least 180 days prior to the current permit's expiration date is a Class 2 violation of our enforcement rules and may disqualify an applicant from the automatic permit extension shield. Under this scenario, if the application is not received in a timely manner and the Department is not able to issue a new permit by the expiration date of the prior permit, the applicant would be faced with the option of discontinuing operation until a new permit has been issued, or operating without a valid permit.
