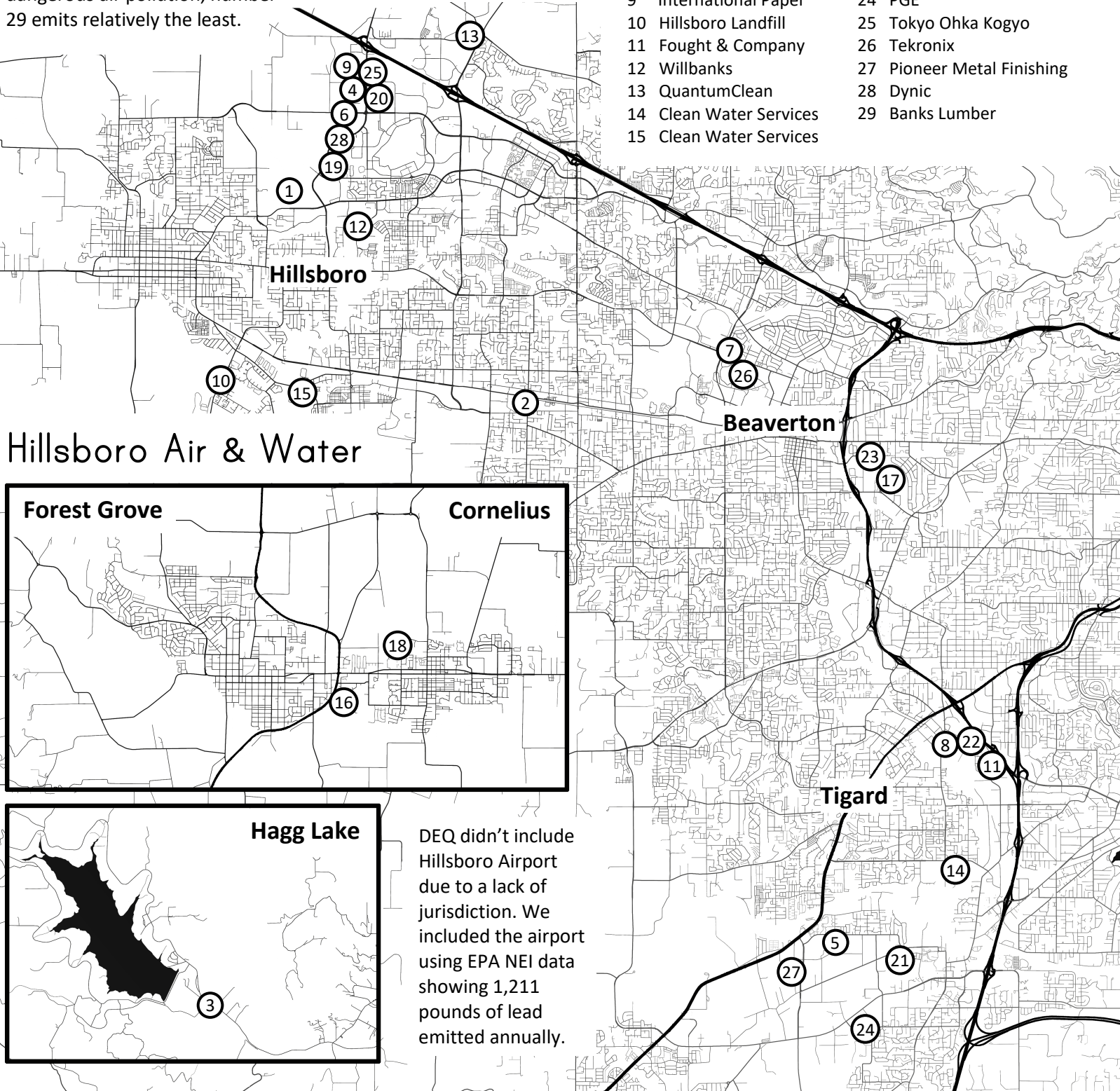

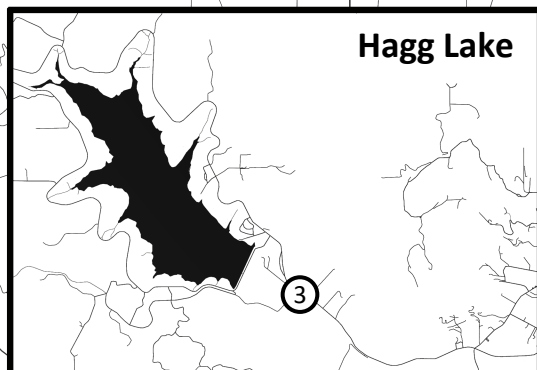
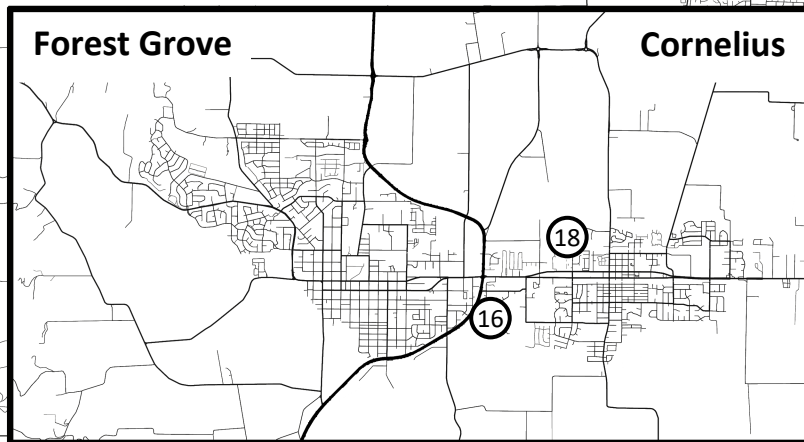
Hillsboro air polluters ranked by risk to human health

These maps show a comparison of Cleaner Air Oregon Chemical Balance Sheet data for the largest industries in Washington County. The numbers below rank DEQ's Level I Screening, a preliminary assessment of the health effects of chemical emissions. Number 1 on this map, Intel, emits the most dangerous air pollution, number 29 emits relatively the least.
